Raising Kids

READING WITH YOUR CHILD

Discover the many reasons why reading aloud with your child has such a big impact on their literacy development and social-emotional growth.

Reading aloud is one of the most important things parents can do with their children. It introduces rich new words, models fluent and expressive reading, and shows children how wonderful books can be. Reading together each day can also become a special family tradition.

Regular reading helps build early literacy skills such as rhyming, letter recognition, listening, focus, and hearing the sounds in words. These skills are important for school success and help children grow into confident readers. Books also strengthen language development by exposing children to new vocabulary, story structure, and comprehension skills such as predicting, asking questions, and understanding characters.

Reading a variety of books helps children learn about the world around them. Stories introduce different places, cultures, people, emotions, and experiences. Some books act as “windows,” helping children see the lives of others, while others act as “mirrors,” helping children see themselves in positive and meaningful ways.

Reading aloud also supports social-emotional growth. Many children’s books teach lessons about friendship, kindness, problem-solving, and handling big feelings. Talking about stories gives children a safe way to understand their own emotions and learn how to relate to others.

Most importantly, reading aloud nurtures a lifelong love of reading. When children connect books with warmth, love, and time spent with family, they are more likely to enjoy reading as they grow. It is more than learning — it is a special time to bond, talk, snuggle, ask questions, and share the joy of a good story together.
